- ☐ You will leave this program with communication, problem solving, leadership, teamwork, and adaptability skills.

As the name implies:

- ☐ You will be a member of a team and therefore responsible to build a team spirit and to work together with your fellow team members in a variety of different settings.

Within the team you will:

- ☐ Identify your own personal strengths, growing edges and learning goals
- ☐ Use your skills and personality to grow a professional, caring and effective team.

Over the course of the program, each Team Member will:

- ☐ Welcome, encourage and motivate participants.
- ☐ Build a comfortable and safe environment for participation.
- ☐ Lead and facilitate activities
- ☐ Develop leadership techniques, personal interaction and discipline strategies, as well as develop programs for the children you work with
